Our mission

Our mission is to donate to underprivileged children; payment for a uniform, book pack, shoes, bag and school fees, this will allow them to have everything they need so they can excel at school and not be worried about their appearance. We are also collecting books and school items to pass on to children in need. We believe it is important to give children what they need to flourish at school and feel like an equal to their peers.

We are also collecting essential items to donate to the homeless, such as toiletries, blankets, travel cup, tea & coffee, cup of soup, cup of noodles, towel & face washer, sunscreen, small long-life milk, female hygiene products (females only) and a bag to keep it all in. We are all human and we all deserve to be treated with the same respect and care. We as a community can help to give those less fortunate the essentials so they can also be comfortable.

We are collecting goods to provide overnight essential packages for children who have been victims of domestic violence or are entering the fostering system. Items like a pair of pyjamas, toiletries, a teddy, a set of clothes, a colouring book and some pencils, a small notebook, anything we can do to help these children feel secure and comfortable is important.

We will also try to secure funding to be able to help families with a small voucher for food or essentials.

We are fundraising and seeking grants to fund all of these items but we also are reliant on donations from the community. Any thing you can do to help would be amazing.

We will be collecting goods (food and essentials) and helping to fundraise for other charities as we are all here trying to make a difference to the community and if we are able to support each other this will be beneficial for the whole community.

A simple donation can make such a difference to someone who is trying to be positive and turn their life around.

Our vision

Our vision is to help individuals and families get back on their feet, so that more time can be spent enjoying life. We help individuals and families in the community who are in need of a new start or need a little help to lighten the burden. We hope to develop the organisation and be able to cater for those in need within the Moreton Bay Region.

We rely on the hearts of others to donate time, money, new items toward our packages that will help people that we are collecting for in our community. The donation of money will allow our team to purchase items and provide to the families and individuals in the community who need it the most.

Our organisation is reliant on the public donating goods or funds so we are able to forward it on to those in need and help where we can.

One of the ways we can help is to apply for grants and fundraising. This is to help us to sponsor children for essential items to go to school with and to purchase care packages for the homeless, foster children, books for kids etc.

We want to support our community as much as possible and help as many people as we can. Redcliffe Mums just want to do their part to make a difference.

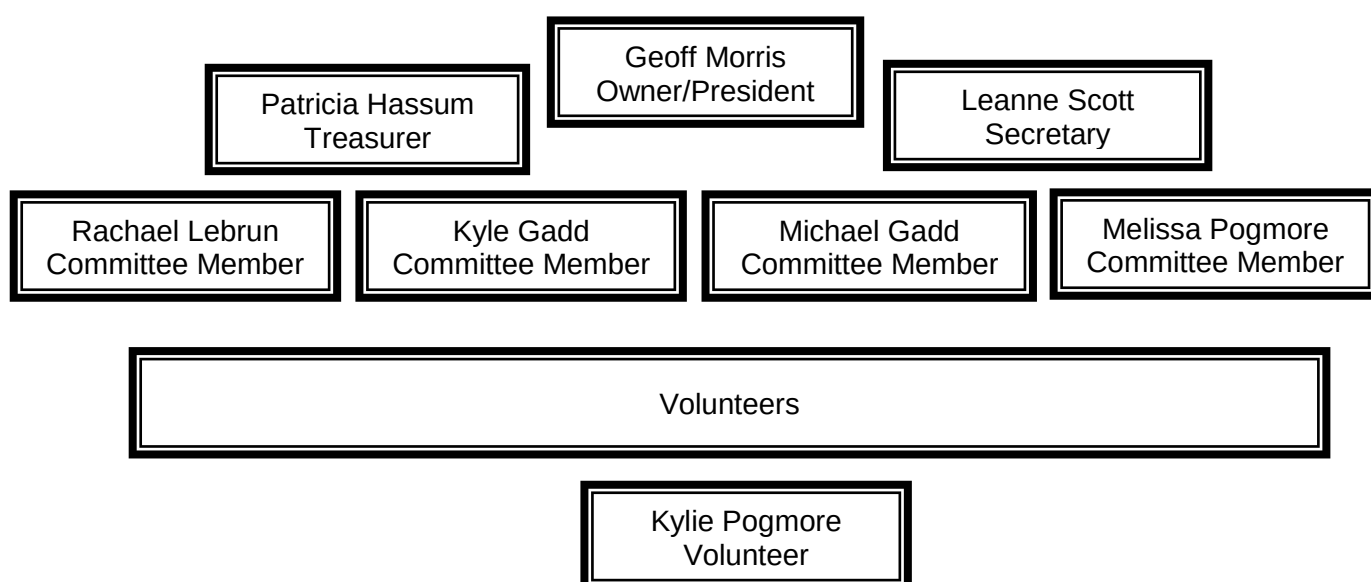

- Redcliffe Mums is in the processes of trying to get funding to be able to help those in the community.
- We are discussing with the Australian Gateball Union a possible function to introduce Redcliffe Mums Inc to the community. The details are still being sorted but basically it will be a function for the AGU which will fundraise money for RMI. There will be a Gateball game, raffles, food platters, live music and face painting / airbrushing. We will be looking at doing extra fundraising; eg possible lucky numbers, meat trays etc.
- We are trying to contact other associations and introduce them to RMI
- We are also presently applying for grants to try to get funds to help students with their school needs.
- We are pushing for this year to be our year to get this ball rolling and really get ourselves involved within the community and get out there helping people.
- We are making it a must to have posts on Instagram and Facebook and we are trying to increase our likes, and the awareness that Redcliffe Mums Inc is within the community to help.
- We were awarded a fantastic grant through the year from The Gambling Community Benefit Fund which has helped us to buy some essential set up items for Redcliffe Mums. We have purchased a laptop & accessories, 2 x IPAD's, Printer, Chairs, Filing Cabinets, Signage, Phones. It was a wonderful grant to be awarded and it will help us to get this charity moving.
- We are working on networking with other organisations and contacts to get affiliations in place.

This is going to be an exciting year for Redcliffe Mums and we are hoping to being able to start helping the community.

Gift Certificates

School Packages

We aim to use some of the funds to create School Packages for children. These will include: 1 school uniform, 1 pair of shoes, a school bag and a book pack. We also do a larger pack which will include some school fees and essentials.

Donation of Essentials Pack

Prepare your own essentials pack to donate to children that have entered the foster system or have experienced domestic violence or other difficult situations which cause them to be removed from their family. Below are just some examples:

- Baby – Nappies, Baby Wipes, Nappy Rash Cream, Baby Soap/Shampoo, Pacifier, Toy, Towel, Face Washer, Bottle, Baby Bag
- Kids – Towel, Face Washer, Soap – Sensitive, Tooth Brush, Tooth Paste, Comb/Brush, Shampoo, Conditioner, Pyjamas, Soft Toy, Carry Bag, colouring book / notebook.
- Young Adult/Adult – Antiperspirant Deodorant, Tooth Brush, Tooth Paste, Soap, Towel, Face Washer, Shampoo/Conditioner, Moisturiser, Carry Bag, colouring book / notebook.

- Homeless – Blanket, Towel, face washer, Jacket, Soap, Shampoo/Conditioner, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Sunscreen, Pillow, Mosquito Spray, Moisturiser, tea / coffee, travel cup, cup of soup, cup of noodles.
- Gift Card – Email, post or drop off your gift cards to allow our Staff to go shopping for you.
