Our Purpose

Redcliffe Mums Incorporated was established with the specific purpose of helping families and individuals in the Redcliffe Area of the Moreton Bay region get back on their feet. The team at Redcliffe Mums Incorporated have come together with a common goal to make a difference and lighten the load to others in need.

Our Mission

Our mission is to support underprivileged children by fund raising and holding events to help these kids with the cost of uniforms, book packs, school fees and charges, shoes, jumpers, bags, excursions and camps. We want to help these kids have everything they need so they can excel at school and not be worried not having these essential items. Kids are resilient but they will often hide in the background so their differences aren't as noticed by their peers. We are also collecting books and school items to pass on to children in need. We believe it is important to give children what they need to flourish at school and feel like an equal to their classmates.

We are fundraising and seeking grants to fund these items but we also are reliant on donations from the community.

Our Vision

Our vision is to help individuals and families get back on their feet, so that more time can be spent enjoying life. We help individuals and families in the community who are in need of items to help with their children's education to give them a little help to lighten the burden. We hope to develop the organisation and be able to cater for those in need within the entire Moreton Bay Region.

We rely on the hearts of people within the community to donate their time, financial support, new items toward our school packages that will go toward items that we are collecting for kids in our community. The donation of funds will allow our team to support people in need and purchase items for the kids in the community who need it the most.

Our organisation is reliant on the public donating goods or funds so we are able to forward it on to those in need and help where we can.

One of the ways we can help is to apply for community grants and via fundraising. This is to help us to sponsor children for essential items to go to school with and to purchase care packages for families that are struggling.

We want to support our community as much as possible and help as many people as we can. Redcliffe Mums Inc just wants to do their part to make a difference.

Our Achievements for 2020

This year has been a difficult year in trying to get out into the community, largely due to the various restrictions placed on everyone by the global COVID-19 pandemic. We have however managed to get out in the community a little.

We were fortunate to work with Ray White Redcliffe in their little Ray of Giving Initiative where they collected gifts from the community, we found the right people to donate these gifts to.

We helped the Care Network pack hampers and hand out to those in the community that needed support.

This year we did have a family fun day community event planned with the Australian Gateball Union to raise money for kids to get their school essentials. This event was postponed to February 2021 due to COVID-19 restrictions.

We have been applying for several grants to find funding to help the community and will continue to do this throughout the year.

We are slowly starting to affiliate ourselves with other charities and organisations to give us contacts to broaden our reach and help us to support other charities.

We were awarded a fantastic grant from the Moreton Bay Regional Council to hold a Trivia Night in March 2021 which will cover all of the costs of this and allow us to just raise money and give the community a great night. Hopefully this will be the first of many Trivia Nights or events to come.

We are getting great use of the equipment that was awarded to us from a grant from the Gambling Community Benefit Fund which has really been fantastic to help us to set up this charity and get us on the way to be able to support the community.

Redcliffe Mums Inc. is excited to get out into this community and help people the best way we can as well as support other charities and organisations.

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About Us

Redcliffe Mums Incorporated is a Not for Profit organisation. We currently have 7 members / volunteers who are committee members. The people involved do not have any legal issues as far as they know and the organisation has not acted in any way that could be a serious offence under Australian Law. We are registered with the ACNC and are endorsed by the ATO for Charity Tax Concessions and DGR Status.

The team at Redcliffe Mums Inc. include a range of people (not just mums) from the local Moreton Bay Community. We are a group of people who have come together to make a difference to those in the local community who are in need.

Our vision is to help individuals and families in need to get back on their feet, so that more time can be spent enjoying life. We aim to help the individuals and families in the community who need a little help to lighten the burden. This may be either the purchase of goods or direct financial support through the local schools.

We rely on the support of people in the broader community to donate their time and to help us to raise funds towards supporting the underprivileged kids in our local schools, this directly helps people in our community help their children have the resources they need to get a quality education and change their circumstances. The donation of funds will allow our team to purchase items and provide to the families and individuals in the community who need it the most.

The main way we can raise funds is via community grants and / or directly via fundraising events.

We want to support our community as much as possible and help as many people as we can. Redcliffe Mums Incorporated wants to do their part to make a real difference in the lives of children and their families.

Redcliffe Mums Inc want to give the gift of acceptance, to end the boundaries of poverty and inequality and create a balance within the schools so all kids have the same chance to create a better future with the knowledge and reassurance that they have the support of their local community.

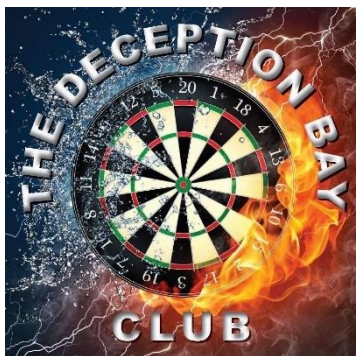

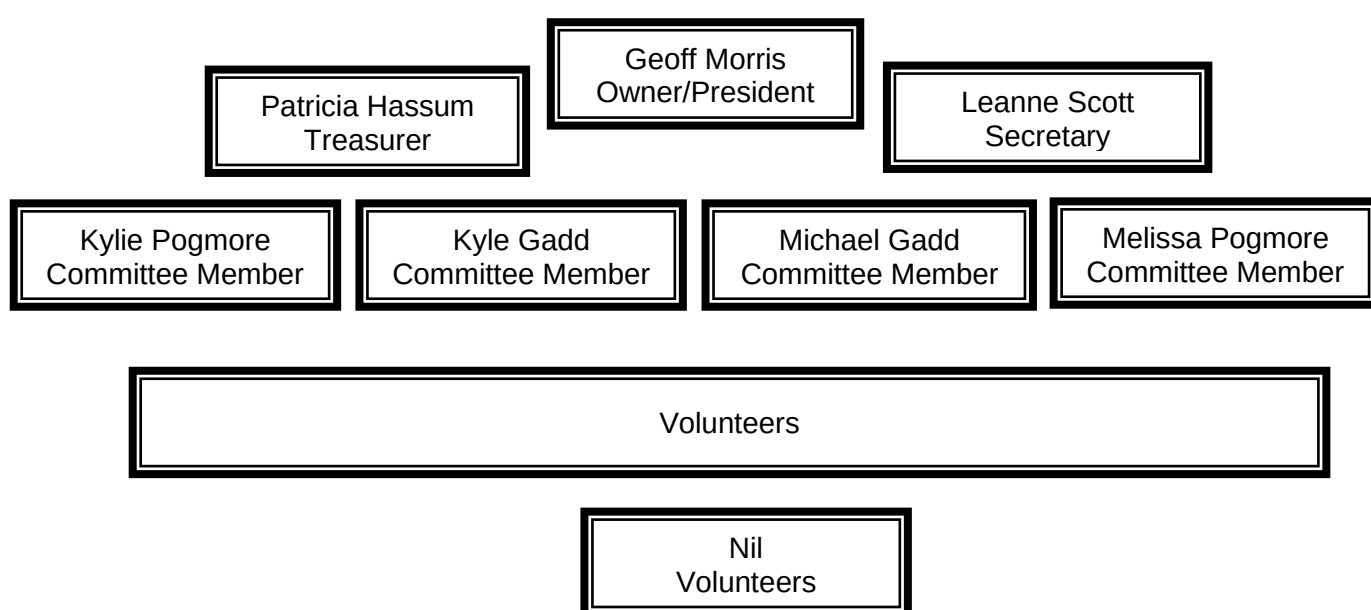

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Geoff Morris

Welcome committee and members to our AGM for Redcliffe Mums Incorporated.

Redcliffe Mums has been actively getting its name out in the community and establishing our way of helping members of the community. We have had some slow but steady progress and finally some positive things are starting to happen.

We were successfully awarded a grant from the Moreton Bay Shire Council Discretionary Funds for \$1,000.00. These funds were divided equally and were donated to the Clontarf Beach State School and the Clontarf Beach State High School. These funds went toward text book fees, school fees, excursion fees for 10 Students who needed it.

We were included in the Grant received from the Australian Gateball Union to put on a Gateball Charity Fundraising Day which was postponed due to COVID-19 regulations and subsequently was held in February 2021. This event was sponsored by the Moreton Bay Shire Council for \$3,950.00. This event included a Gateball Game, Mini Gateball Games, Face Painting, Air Brushing Tattoos, Live Music, Meat Trays and Raffles. There was some food and drinks provided at this event. All proceeds from this event went to Redcliffe Mums Inc.

We were privileged to be asked by the Redcliffe Ray White Team to be part of their Little Ray of Giving Appeal. This appeal is to the community to donate Christmas presents to those who need it most. Redcliffe Mums Inc were asked to be part of the distribution of these gifts to the community.

We have been trying to connect with The Care Network within Redcliffe which consists of The Salvation Army, Encircle, The Breakfast Club & The Uniting Church. We made several unsuccessful attempts to do this but keep trying as we believed this was the best way to get these gifts to where they were needed most. We also considered trying to do an appeal for food hampers to help with this cause.

Eventually we were successful in connecting with these organisations and we donated the gifts collected by Redcliffe Ray White. We also helped them to pack and distribute their food hampers to the community in need.

Redcliffe Mums Inc has been awarded a grant from the Moreton Bay Shire Council to put on a Trivia Night in 2021. This grant is for \$1,937.00 and goes toward raffles, meat trays, advertising, decorations, printing etc to hold the Trivia Night. We propose to hold this event on Saturday the 20th March 2021. All proceeds from this event will go directly to Redcliffe Mums which will provide us with further funding to distribute to the disadvantaged in the community.

We propose to hold another Committee Meeting as soon as possible after the 20th of March 2021 event to discuss the distribution of any funds that are raised at these two events. We would like this meeting to take place possibly in the March to allow us to get these funds to the kids in the local schools as close to the beginning of the year as possible.

In closing a fair amount has been happening and progress is being made, we are continually applying for grants for any opportunities that come up so we can raise funds to help people that need our help in the community.

Despite the Government regulations and challenges placed by the global COVID-19 pandemic (which commenced in late February 2020), it was a fairly successful year for Redcliffe Mums Incorporated as we make our way out into the general community and help as many people as we can.

OUR OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Our objectives during the year were to finalise documentation, arrange and initiate the relevant tools required for our organisation to work properly. We have worked together to obtain the correct affiliations and aim to focus on building better relationships within the area and developing these further to obtain funds, vouchers and donations. This also includes working further with organisations who can advise us who actually needs our help.

Our main objective during this year was to get Redcliffe Mums Incorporated out into the community, fund raising, developing our affiliations, being a part of helping members of the community and finding ways of making a difference.

We will continue to apply for grants for funding to hold fundraising events to allow us to raise money for the members of the community which need it the most.

We were awarded a grant from the Moreton Bay Shire Council for \$1,000.00 to give to some of the local schools to help disadvantaged kids with their schooling needs.

We have been organising the two fund raising events that are in February and March next year which we hope will have some success in firstly getting Redcliffe Mums Inc known within the community and secondly raising funds for the disadvantaged kids.

We were able to be part of the Redcliffe Ray White – Little Ray of giving which gave Christmas presents to those in the community that struggle to do this. This initiative also allowed us to affiliate with other charitable organisations within the area and become part of the packing and distribution of hampers to the community with the Redcliffe Care Network. It was a great honour to be part of such an amazing community.

Several of our volunteers already have Blue Cards. We are now seeking other members to also obtain their Blue Cards in the following year.

We need to look at having meetings with organisations and other charities to affiliate ourselves and find out where Redcliffe Mums Incorporated can best be a positive influence within the community.

All in all it was a busy year for Redcliffe Mums Inc and some definite progress was made in relation to getting out into the community, affiliating ourselves with other organisations and some fund raising was done to help members of the community.

We have a big year planned for 2021 and we hope for as much progress to be made as we have made this year.
