## Our Purpose

*Redcliffe Mums Incorporated was established with the specific purpose of helping families and individuals in the Redcliffe Area of the Moreton Bay region get back on their feet. The team at Redcliffe Mums Incorporated have come together with a common goal to make a difference and lighten the load to others in need. This year we have focused on supporting disadvantaged school kids to be able to have their school essential items so they have access to the same education as their peers.*

## Our Mission

*Our mission for 2021 has been to support disadvantaged children by fund raising and holding events to help these kids with the cost of uniforms, book packs, school fees and charges, shoes, jumpers, bags, excursions and camps. We want to support these children to have everything they need so they can excel at school and not be worried about not having these essential items. Children are resilient but they will often hide in the background so their differences aren't noticed by their peers. We are also collecting books and school items to pass on to children in need. We believe it is important to give children what they need to flourish at school and feel like an equal to their classmates.*

*We are fundraising and seeking grants to fund these items but we also are reliant on donations from the community.*

## Our Vision

*Our vision is to help individuals and families get back on their feet, so that more time can be spent enjoying life. We help individuals and families in the community who need essential items to help lighten the burden. We hope to develop the organisation and be able to cater for those in need within the entire Moreton Bay Region.*

*We rely on the hearts of people within the community to donate their time, financial support, new items toward our essential items that will go toward supporting families in our community. One of the ways we also collect funds is via applying for community grants and holding fund raising events. The donation of funds will allow our team to support people in need and purchase essential items for those in the community who need it the most.*

*We want to support our community as much as possible and help as many people as we can. Redcliffe Mums Inc just wants to do their part to make a difference.*

## Our Achievements for 2021

This year has been amazing for Redcliffe Mums Inc, we have achieved so much during this year and have had some rapid growth to the organisation during the year.

We have been networking with the local schools on the Peninsula and into Deception Bay and have been making fantastic progress getting Redcliffe Mums Inc's name out into the community.

We have held several fundraising events in 2021 beginning with;

BBQ at Bunnings

Our first fundraiser we raised \$595.02

Family Fun Day in February with Australian Gateball Union

Thank you to the AGU & the Moreton Bay Regional Council for supporting us and funding this event. We were able to raise \$929.90 for disadvantaged kids.

Trivia Night on the 20<sup>th</sup> March 2021

This event was fully funded by the Moreton Bay Regional Council and our first ever Trivia Night, we learnt a lot and were able to raise \$1,667.34.

We received a grant from the Moreton Bay Regional Council to put on our first Trivia for \$1,937.00 which allowed Redcliffe Mums Inc to get the items needed to begin putting on these Trivia Nights. This grant helped us to start our fundraising capabilities by providing the items required to start our fundraising adventure. We also purchased advertising items for these trivia nights.

Trivia Night on the 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021 – Cancelled by Covid

This event was cancelled due to a snap lockdown on the day of the event, we had to reschedule the event with the people that were attending. We were able to secure a grant from the Moreton Bay Regional Council for \$300.00 for the venue fees. We rolled all of the event purchases to the next event.

Trivia Night 11<sup>th</sup> September 2021

A grant was awarded to Redcliffe Mums in from the Moreton Bay Regional Council for \$1,065.00. We successfully raised \$2,567.74 for our charity. We did really well with this event and everyone that attended had a great time, we have some members of the community that now attend most of our events. This night was a great success.

Discretionary Funds Grant

We were awarded a grant for \$600.00 from the Moreton Bay Regional Council to get school packs for kids. We purchased school packs for the Deception Bay North State School for their students. Deception Bay North State School was so grateful for the donation of book packs and stated to us that this was the first time all of their students had their book packs.

### Trivia Night 27<sup>th</sup> November 2021

We were awarded a grant from the Moreton Bay Regional Council for \$1,929.00 which was to help us to put on a Trivia Night to raise funds for kids and purchase some more signage and printing items to promote our events. We were able to raise \$1,732.26 from this event to donate to the local schools. We have learnt more from running these events including timing of the events, this event was too close to December.

We have also successfully been awarded a grant from the Gambling Community Benefit Fund for \$1,550.00. This grant is to help us put on a future Trivia Night and some extra signage and advertising our events.

### Donations to Schools

Our organisation has donated \$5,500.00 to 12 different schools in our local area from our fund-raising efforts. We are also purchasing some items for individuals and other charities to support their school pack donations as well as supporting some individual members of the community to help them get their children school uniforms and book packs.

Redcliffe Mums has been invited to be part of the Redcliffe Care Network, we have been attending planning meetings throughout the year and was part of the planning of the Christmas hamper and present drive for members of the community that need our help and support. This is such a rewarding experience and we are proud to be part of this Network of Not-for-Profit Organisations in Redcliffe and will continue to be part of this in the future.

Ray White Redcliffe generously held the Ray of Giving appeal this year and donated these gifts to Redcliffe Mums. The gifts received were distributed within the Christmas hampers and gifts with the Care Network. We added the gifts to the rest of the donated presents that were there for members of the community to choose for their children.

We are still applying for grants to find further funding for our events and to help as many families as we can.

We have achieved so much this year in our events, donations, community awareness and networking with other organisations. Thank you to our committee members that have worked hard and donated their time and effort to help their community, thank you to members of the community that are supporting us, it is incredible to see how many good people there are in the world that want to make a difference. We have made real progress this year and would like to do more next year and help more kids.

Redcliffe Mums Inc. is excited to get out into this community and help people the best way we can as well as support other charities and organisations.

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## About Us

Redcliffe Mums Incorporated is a Not-for-Profit organisation. We currently have 7 members / volunteers who are committee members. The people involved do not have any legal issues as far as they know and the organisation has not acted in any way that could be a serious offence under Australian Law. We are registered with the ACNC and are endorsed by the ATO for Charity Tax Concessions and DGR Status.

The team at Redcliffe Mums Inc. include a range of people (not just mums) from the local Moreton Bay Community. We are a group of people who have come together to make a difference to those in the local community who are in need.

Our vision is to help individuals and families in need to get back on their feet, so that more time can be spent enjoying life. We aim to help the individuals and families in the community who need a little help to lighten the burden. This may be either the purchase of goods or direct financial support through the local schools.

We rely on the support of people in the broader community to donate their time and to help us to raise funds towards supporting the underprivileged children in our local schools, this directly helps people in our community help their children have the resources they need to get a quality education and change their circumstances. The donation of funds will allow our team to purchase items and provide to the families and individuals in the community who need it the most.

The main way we can raise funds is via community grants and / or directly via fundraising events.

We want to support our community as much as possible and help as many people as we can. Redcliffe Mums Incorporated wants to do their part to make a real difference in the lives of children and their families.

Redcliffe Mums Inc want to give the gift of acceptance, to end the boundaries of poverty and inequality and create a balance within the schools so all children have the same chance to create a better future with the knowledge and reassurance that they have the support of their local community.

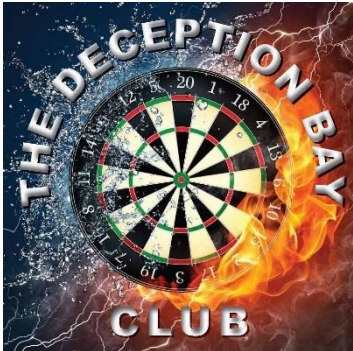

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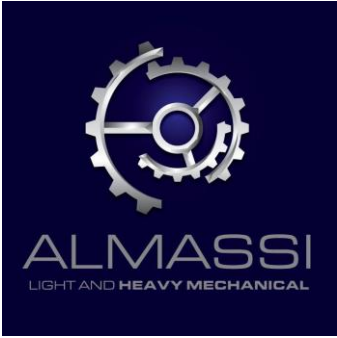

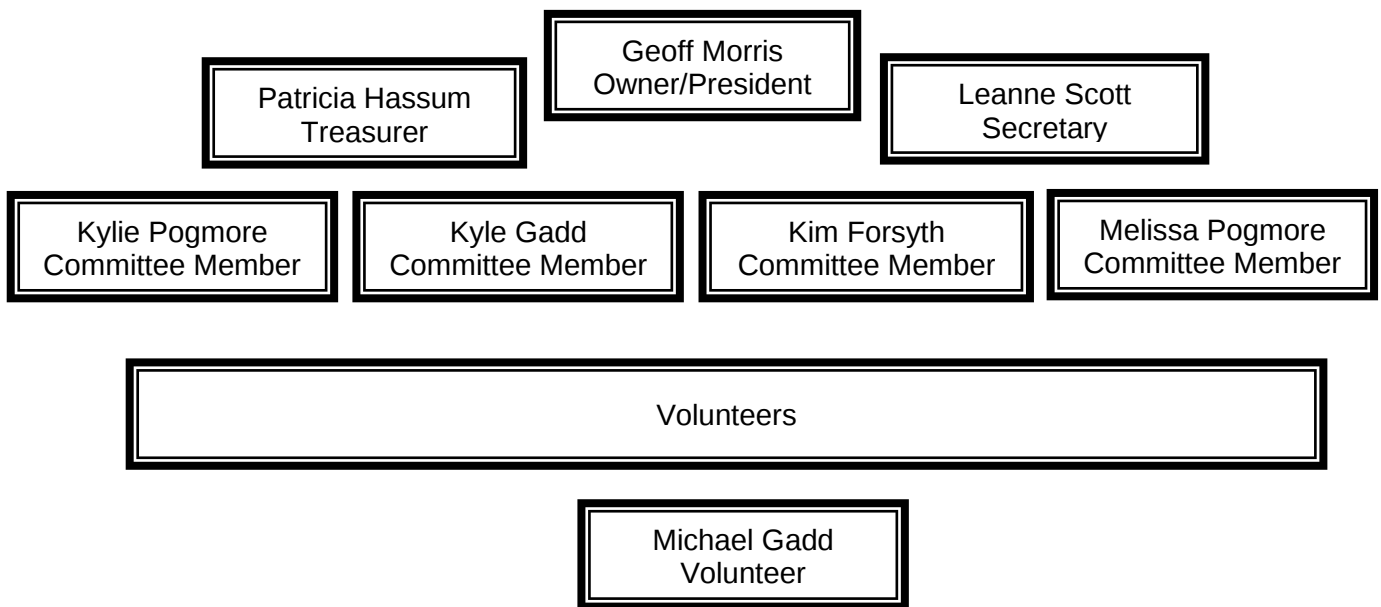

## CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Welcome committee and members to our AGM for Redcliffe Mums Incorporated.

What a year it has been for Redcliffe Mums, since our slow beginnings due to changes and COVID implications, we have achieved a lot within the year and are continuing our rapid growth.

Trish and Kim have been doing a lot of networking with the local schools on the Peninsula and into Deception Bay. We have point of contacts for all of these schools and have really been getting Redcliffe Mums Inc name out into the community. They have also been networking with the local businesses and people in the community. We still need to arrange meetings with some government organisations and businesses within the community to continue our growth.

We had our very first BBQ at Bunnings which was a lot of hard work but we were able to raise \$595.02 for the kids.

We held the Family Fun Day with the Australian Gateball Union in February, unfortunately we didn't get the people we were hoping for, but we were still able to raise \$929.90 thanks to the kind donation of fees received from the AGU plus the raffle prizes. This event was fully funded by the Moreton Bay Regional Council to the Australian Gateball Union whom generously involved us in their event to help raise funds for Redcliffe Mums Inc.

We held our very first Trivia Night on the 20<sup>th</sup> March 2021. We learnt a lot from our first Trivia Night and we successfully raised \$1,667.34 not too bad for our first try. This event was also fully funded from the Moreton Bay Regional Council without them that event would not have been possible. The Moreton Bay Regional Council generously awarded Redcliffe Mums \$1,937.00 for this event. This grant was received last year but the event was held this year.

Our next event was to be held on the 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021 another Trivia Night; the Moreton Bay Council had awarded us a grant for venue fees of \$300.00 for this event. So many prizes for this event were donated by members of the community that wanted to support Redcliffe Mums and our cause to help disadvantaged kids. Unfortunately, due to a late COVID-19 lockdown on the same day as our event, we had to cancel this event. All prizes and funding were transferred to our next event.

Our next event was a Trivia night held on the 11<sup>th</sup> September 2021. The funding for this event was awarded to Redcliffe Mums from the Moreton Bay Regional Council in a grant for \$1,065.00. What a successful night, we had a lot of positive feedback from members of the community and people had a fantastic night. We successfully raised \$2,567.74 less amount for prize money and other expenses we had an amazing night and raised an amazing amount for our charity.

We were successfully awarded a grant from the discretionary funds from the Moreton Bay Regional Council for \$600.00 for School Packs for kids. Within our networking with schools the Deception Bay North State School would prefer a donation of book packs and uniforms. This grant will be used as part of our donation to The Deception Bay North State School by purchasing School Packs for the kids that attend this school. Kim has been talking to some of the stationary suppliers to see if we can increase the book supplies that we can purchase with these funds with their support.

Redcliffe Mums have also been awarded a grant from the Moreton Bay Regional Council for \$1,929.00 to hold a Trivia Night on the 27<sup>th</sup> November 2021. This grant is amazing and will fully fund our event thanks to the Moreton Bay Shire Council.

Redcliffe Mums has also successfully been awarded a grant from the Gambling Fund for \$1,550.00. This grant was awarded to allow us to put on a Trivia Night. We will be holding this Trivia Night on the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2022 as the acquittal is not due till the 9<sup>th</sup> of February 2022 and we already have another Trivia Night planned this year so there will not be time to hold another in this year.

Redcliffe Mums Inc has been invited to be a part in the Redcliffe Care Network, last year we only joined this event at the end of the year but now we are a part of the planning of the Christmas hamper and present drive for members of the community that need our help and support.

We are a contact for this event and we may receive members of the community to fill out forms to apply for support from the Care Network in the form of a food hamper and possibly a gift for their children. We are honoured to be a part of this event as last year we found this to be very rewarding and allowed us to also get to know the other charity organisations on the Peninsula.

We have also been advised that Ray White will be holding the Ray of Giving appeal again this year so we should have some gifts to add to the Care Networks present appeal. Last year Ray White Redcliffe with the support of the community were so generous and so many gifts were donated to those in the community that needed our support. We hope this year will be as successful as last year and we are looking forward to being a part of the Care Network and helping the community in the toughest time of the year for a lot of families in the area.

We have been lucky to have some generous members of the community that have been regularly donating funds to us and local business that have donated prizes for our events. It has been incredible to see the support and kindness from the community.

Last year we donated \$1,000 to two schools on the peninsula. This year so far, we have donated \$3,000.00 to six schools within the Redcliffe and Deception Bay areas. We at least have enough to allocate a further \$2,000.00 to schools within the Redcliffe and Deception Bay areas after our AGM. Since Redcliffe Mums Inc has started, we have raised \$6,000 to give to local schools to help disadvantaged kids. This has gone to approximately 10 different schools in the community. We should be proud of what we have been able to achieve already and be excited for what we will be able to do in the future.

In closing this year, Redcliffe Mums has come a long way, we have raised funds for the community, been part of amazing events and helped disadvantaged families within the community. What an amazing year and thank you to our committee members and volunteers for their hard work and sacrifices and thank you to the members of the community that are supporting us. It is incredible to see how many good people there are in the world that want to make a difference.

We have been applying for grants to establish funding to hold fund-raising events, these events allow us to give more to the community as we are not having to fund our events.

Another of our objectives is to grow Redcliffe Mums Inc and do our best to find ways to make a difference to as many people as possible.

We will continue to apply for grants and hold fundraising events to allow us to raise money for the members of the community which need it the most as well as continue to establish real connections within the schools, local not-for-profits and work together to find real solutions to community problems.

We were awarded a several grants from the Moreton Bay Shire Council for putting on our trivia nights as well as allowing us to get book packs for schools to give to some of the disadvantaged kids with their schooling needs. The Gambling Community Benefit Fund also helped us by a grant to organise a trivia night.

We were able to be part of the Redcliffe Ray White – Little Ray of giving which gave Christmas presents to those in the community that struggle to do this. This initiative also allowed us to affiliate with other charitable organisations within the area and become part of the packing and distribution of hampers to the community with the Redcliffe Care Network. It was a great honour to be part of such an amazing community.

Several of our volunteers already have Blue Cards. We are now seeking other members to also obtain their Blue Cards in the following year.

All in all, it has been a busy year for Redcliffe Mums Inc and some definite progress was made in relation to getting out into the community, affiliating ourselves with other organisations and some fund raising was done to help members of the community.

We have a big year planned for 2022 and we hope for as much progress to be made as we have made this year.
