Our Purpose

Redcliffe Mums Incorporated was established with the specific purpose of helping families and individuals in the Redcliffe Area of the Moreton Bay region get back on their feet. The team at Redcliffe Mums Incorporated have come together with a common goal to make a difference and lighten the load to others in need.

Our Mission

Our mission is to support underprivileged children by fund raising and holding events to help kids with the cost of uniforms, book packs, school fees and school charges, shoes, jumpers, bags, excursions and camps. We want to help kids have everything they need so they can excel at school and not be worried not having these essential items. Kids are resilient but they will often hide in the background so their differences aren't as noticed by their peers. We are also collecting books and school items to pass on to children in need. We believe it is important to give children what they need to flourish at school and feel like an equal to their classmates.

We are fundraising and seeking grants to fund these items but we also are reliant on donations from the community.

Our Vision

Our vision is to help individuals and families get back on their feet, so that more time can be spent enjoying life. We help individuals and families in the community who are in need of items to help with their children's education to give them a little help to lighten the burden. We hope to develop the organisation and be able to cater for those in need within the entire Moreton Bay Region.

We rely on the hearts of people within the community to donate their time, financial support, new items toward our school packages that will go toward items that we are collecting for kids in our community. The donation of funds will allow our team to support people in need and purchase items for the kids in the community who need it the most.

Our organisation is reliant on the public donating goods or funds and supporting our events so we are able to forward it on to those in need and help where we can.

One of the ways we can help is to apply for community grants and via fundraising. This is to help us to sponsor children for essential items to go to school with and to purchase care packages for families that are struggling.

We want to support our community as much as possible and help as many people as we can. Redcliffe Mums Inc just wants to do their part to make a difference.

Our Achievements for 2022

For Redcliffe Mums Inc the year 2022 has been a busy year, we have achieved so much during this year and have had some rapid growth to the organisation and to our network of not for profits within the community.

We have been networking with the local schools on the Peninsula and into Deception Bay and have really been getting Redcliffe Mums Inc's name out into the community.

We have received the \$9,932.00 in grants throughout the year toward our events as well as a \$1,400.00 grant which allowed us to help 60 children get a school jumper for winter in four schools.

We received a grant for \$2,480.00 from Moreton Bay Regional Council for additional items to go in Xmas Hampers for the disadvantaged members in the community as part of our efforts within the Redcliffe Community Care Network. This year with the other organisations that are a part of this network, we packed and handed out almost 500 food hampers to families and couples / singles that are struggling as well as helping some families have a Christmas gift for their children.

We have held several fundraising events in 2022 beginning with; Trivia Nights in March, June September and November as well as a Comedy Night in October – with each of these events we have raised \$12,401.45.

We have donated \$9,767.71 in 2022 in cash, uniforms and stationery to 13 schools on the Peninsula and in Deception Bay from the proceeds of our events and we have planned another round of donations of stationery and funding to pay out in early 2023 for the start of the school year.

We have also purchased items to donate to the Breakfast Club for their Back-to-School appeal in January 2023. They organised the Back-to-School 2022 on their own but they have asked us to be part of this in January 2023. We also purchased items to help toward the hampers for the community hamper appeal as our own donation.

We have received an amazing amount of support from the Moreton Bay Regional Council who have supported most of our events this year and helped us to add to the hampers for community members at Christmas.

We have been lucky to have some generous members of the community that have been regularly donating funds to us and local businesses that have donated prizes for our events. It has been incredible to see the support and kindness from the community.

Newport Markets have come onboard as a major supporter and contributor by generously donating a percentage of proceeds from their monthly events.

Redcliffe Mums has achieved a lot over the year, raising funds for the community, creating fundraising events to help disadvantaged families within the community and expanding our reach by working with the Redcliffe Community Care Network. We have donated funds to families, schools and purchased items to support worthy projects in our community. We have achieved a lot for such a small group of people and we are proud of what we have been able to do. Thank you to our committee members and volunteers for all of your hard work, time and efforts throughout the year and thank you to the businesses and members of the community that are continually supporting us, we could not do this without you all.

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About Us

Redcliffe Mums Incorporated is a Not-for-Profit organisation. We currently have 7 members / volunteers who are committee members. The people involved do not have any legal issues as far as they know and the organisation has not acted in any way that could be a serious offence under Australian Law. We are registered with the ACNC and are endorsed by the ATO for Charity Tax Concessions and DGR Status.

The team at Redcliffe Mums Inc. include a range of people (not just mums) from the local Moreton Bay Community. We are a group of people who have come together to make a difference to those in the local community who are in need.

Our vision is to help individuals and families in need to get back on their feet, so that more time can be spent enjoying life. We aim to help the individuals and families in the community who need a little help to lighten the burden. This may be either the purchase of goods or direct financial support through the local schools.

We rely on the support of people in the broader community to donate their time and to help us to raise funds towards supporting the underprivileged kids in our local schools, this directly helps people in our community help their children have the resources they need to get a quality education and change their circumstances. The donation of funds will allow our team to purchase items and provide to the families and individuals in the community who need it the most.

The main way we can raise funds is via community grants and / or directly via fundraising events.

We want to support our community as much as possible and help as many people as we can. Redcliffe Mums Incorporated wants to do their part to make a real difference in the lives of children and their families.

Redcliffe Mums Inc want to give the gift of acceptance, to end the boundaries of poverty and inequality and create a balance within the schools so all kids have the same chance to create a better future with the knowledge and reassurance that they have the support of their local community.

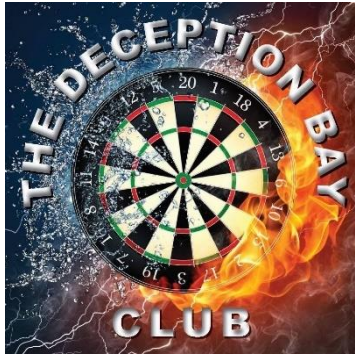

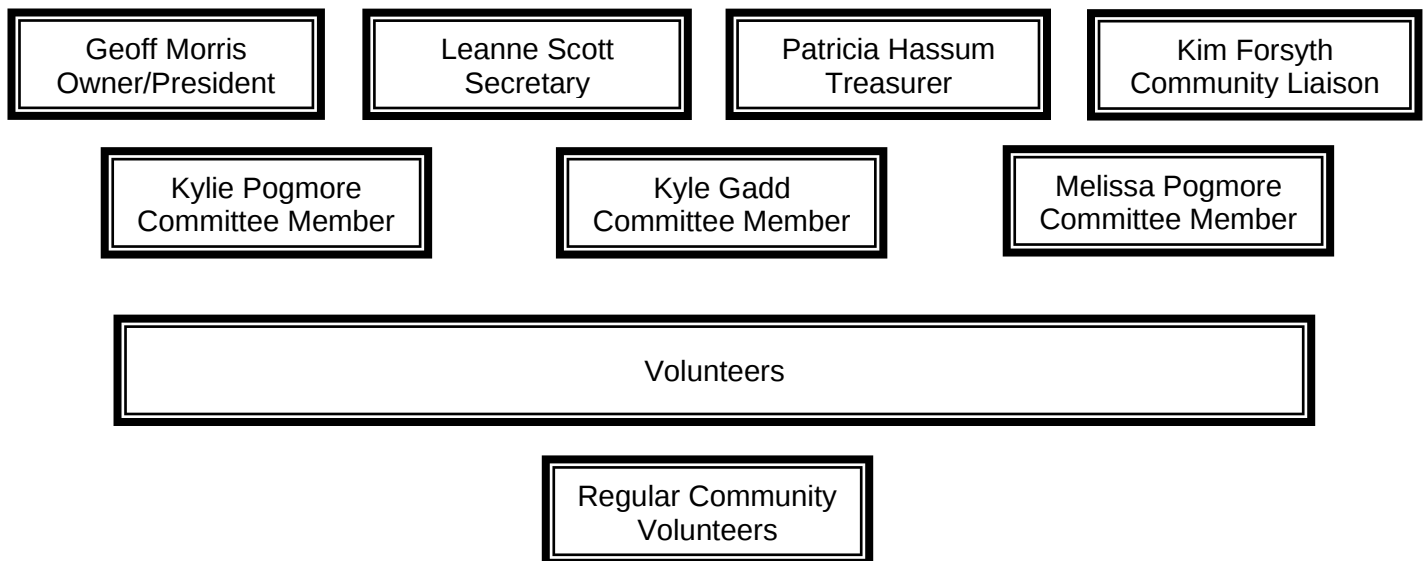

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT - Geoff Morris

Welcome committee and members to our AGM for Redcliffe Mums Incorporated.
What a year for Redcliffe Mums 2022, with community recognition, growth and advancement helping within the community.

We have received the following grants throughout the year

\$1,000.00 from Bioflex Nutrition – Half for a Trivia Night and half for Schools
\$1,400.00 from Moreton Bay Regional Council to purchase jumpers for school kids
This grant allowed us to help 60 children get a jumper for winter for 4 schools. We will attempt to apply for this grant again in 2023.
\$1,557.00 from Moreton Bay Regional Council for a Trivia Night
\$1,561.00 from Moreton Bay Regional Council for a Trivia Night
\$2,480.00 from Moreton Bay Regional Council for additional items to go in Xmas Hampers for the disadvantaged in the community.
\$1,934.00 from Moreton Bay Regional Council for a Trivia Night

In total we have \$9,932.00 for grants throughout the year.

We have received donations of \$1,040.00 from our affiliation with Newport Markets with future events planned each month. We have also one member of the community doing regular monthly donations.

Throughout the year we have held Trivia Nights in March, June, September and November and a comedy night in October – with each of these events we have raised \$12,401.45.

We have donated \$9,767.71 in 2022 in cash, uniforms and stationery to 13 schools on the Peninsula and in Deception Bay from the proceeds of our events and we have planned another round of donations of stationery and funding to pay out in early 2023 for the start of the school year.

We have also purchased items to donate to the Breakfast Club for their Back-to-School appeal in January 2022. They organised the Back-to-School 2022 on their own but they have asked us to be part of this in January 2023. We also purchased items to help toward the hampers for the community hamper appeal as our own donation.

Throughout the year we worked with the Redcliffe Care Network to plan and organise the Community Christmas Hamper drive, supporting the disadvantaged members of the community with a hamper and children's presents for Christmas. We ended up supporting almost 500 people with a hamper and Christmas Presents for families with children.

It is a very rewarding experience being part of the Care Network helping those in the community that need help at the toughest time of the year. We will be looking at ways of expanding what we do within the Care Network to make a larger impact within the community in the future so that will be an exciting journey to look forward to.

We are working on planning with The Breakfast Club to support families trying to get their children back to school with a Back-to-School Packs Event planned for early January 2023 so that is an exciting start to 2023 for Redcliffe Mums Inc.

We have continued to network with the local schools discussing with them the best ways we can help support their students.

Our Trivia Nights is picking up a lot of traction with our last event in November having 20 tables. It was a very busy night but our best fundraiser to date. Hopefully our future events will have the same response from the community.

We are continuing to look for support in the community from local businesses and members of the public. At present this is still a work in progress but we are getting known within the community.

We have received an amazing amount of support from the Moreton Bay Regional Council who have supported most of our events this year and helped us to add to the hampers for community members at Christmas.

We still need to arrange meetings with some government organisations and businesses within the community to continue our growth as well as explore our ideas of expanding who we can help within the Redcliffe Peninsula and Deception Bay Areas.

We have been lucky to have some generous members of the community that have been regularly donating funds to us and local business that have donated prizes for our events. It has been incredible to see the support and kindness from the community.

We should be proud of what we have been able to achieve already and be excited for what we will be able to do in the future.

Our objectives during the year were to continue growing Redcliffe Mums Inc, gaining community awareness and support and really helping members of our community.

We have been fundraising in the community with our Trivia Nights, Comedy Nights to help us support local schools and members of our community that are struggling.

We have been working together with other Not for Profit organisations within the Redcliffe Community Care Network to further support our community with hampers and presents for children at Christmas time and will be collaborating with The Breakfast Club to organise the Back-to-School Appeal in January 2023.

We have worked hard to make affiliations with other organisations and the community so we are able to focus on building better relationships within the community which will allow us to better support people and help us to raise the funds needed to do this.

We have affiliated with the Newport Markets and they will be making regular donations to Redcliffe Mums as well as received support from the Bell Social Club and Vision 1 Architects and silent members of the community which support Redcliffe Mums throughout the year.

Our main objective during this year was to get Redcliffe Mums Incorporated out into the community, fund raising, developing our affiliations, being a part of helping members of the community and finding ways of making a difference.

We will continue to apply for grants for funding to hold fundraising events to allow us to raise money for the members of the community which need it the most.

We have been awarded several grants from the Moreton Bay Regional Council which help to run our events and allow us to give the money made from our events straight to the schools to support the disadvantaged members of the community with their schooling needs. We have also received some funding from Bioflex Nutrition.

We collaborated again this year with the members of the Redcliffe Community Care Network and the packing and distribution of hampers to those who need support. It was a great honour to be part of such an amazing community.

We need to continue to organise meetings with organisations and other charities to affiliate ourselves and find out where Redcliffe Mums Incorporated can best be a positive influence within the area.

All in all, it was a busy year for Redcliffe Mums Inc and some definite progress was made in relation to getting out into the community, affiliating ourselves with other organisations and some fund raising was done to help members of the community. We have a big year planned for 2023 and we hope for as much progress to be made as we have made this year.
