United by a shared commitment to making a meaningful difference, our team is dedicated to creating equal opportunities for all children—particularly in education. We believe that every child deserves the chance to pursue their dreams, and we work to ensure they have the resources and support they need to thrive.

Our Mission

At Redcliffe Mums Incorporated, our mission is to support underprivileged children by helping cover the essential costs of education. Through fundraising efforts, community events, and generous donations, we provide assistance with school uniforms, book packs, fees, shoes, jumpers, bags, excursions, and camps—ensuring every child has what they need to fully participate and thrive at school.

We believe no child should feel left out or disadvantaged because of financial hardship. While many kids are incredibly resilient, they often hide in the background to avoid drawing attention to their struggles. By supplying new school items and books, we aim to boost their confidence, help them feel equal among their peers, and give them the best chance to succeed.

We are actively fundraising, applying for grants, and relying on the generosity of our local community to continue this important work. Every donation helps us give children the opportunity to flourish and focus on learning—not on what they're missing.

Our Vision

At Redcliffe Mums Inc., our vision is to support families and individuals in getting back on their feet—so they can spend more time enjoying life and less time worrying about the basics. We focus on helping those in our community who are struggling to afford essential items for their children's education, providing a helping hand to ease the burden.

Our goal is to grow and expand our support across the entire Moreton Bay Region, reaching more families in need.

We rely on the generosity and compassion of our community—through donations of time, funds, and new school supplies—to help us assemble school packages and care kits for local children. Financial donations are especially vital, enabling us to purchase necessary items and respond quickly to those in need.

As a grassroots organisation, we depend on the public's support: whether it's contributing goods, making a monetary donation, or participating in our events. Every bit helps us make a real difference in someone's life.

We also seek community grants and run regular fundraising initiatives to sponsor children and provide them with school essentials, as well as create care packages for struggling families.

At our core, Redcliffe Mums Inc. is about community. We're committed to doing our part—to reach out, lift up, and support as many people as we can. Together, we can make a lasting difference.

Our Achievements

Redcliffe Mums Inc. – 2024 Year in Review

2024 has been a busy and rewarding year for **Redcliffe Mums Inc.** We've experienced significant growth—both within our organisation and across our network of community partners—and we're proud to have expanded our reach to support more schools and families than ever before.

Growing Our Reach

We've continued to build strong relationships with local schools across the Redcliffe Peninsula and into Deception Bay, and this year we began supporting schools in **Kallangur** and **Caboolture**. Our name is becoming well known throughout the Moreton Bay region, and we're excited to further expand our support in the coming year.

Grant Funding & Support

In 2024, we received a total of **\$10,057 in grant funding** to support our events and initiatives, including:

- **\$6,000** from the **City of Moreton Bay** toward purchasing bacon, eggs, and non-perishable food for **Christmas food hampers**, delivered through the **Redcliffe Community Care Network**.
- **\$4,057** from the **City of Moreton Bay**, which supported nearly all of our events this year. This funding covered costs for our Trivia Nights, allowing us to direct all fundraising proceeds back into the community.
- A **\$1,000 grant** from the **Department of Social Services and Luke Howarth MP** to provide **fuel vouchers** for our amazing volunteers who give their time so generously.

Back to School Drive

In partnership with **The Breakfast Club Redcliffe**, we held our annual **Back to School Drive**, supporting **over 250 students** with essential school items. We also contributed additional supplies to the initiative. These collaborations with other local not-for-profits have taught us so much and helped extend our impact.

Fundraising Highlights

This year, we hosted:

- **4 Trivia Nights**
- **Road Rage Events**
- **Peninsula Motorfest**

Together, these events raised a total of **\$20,878.14**.

We're especially excited about our new partnership with **Peninsula Motorfest**, which helped raise almost **\$4,400** through Road Rage and Motorfest events.

We are grateful to the local businesses that generously donated items for our cent auctions and raffles — your kindness truly makes a difference in our fundraising success.

Community Support & Donations

In 2024, we donated **\$18,110** to support local schools and students — providing uniforms, stationery, and funding for students needing assistance. We are constantly humbled by the support we receive from community members and businesses who continue to donate both funds and goods. Our volunteers, too, have been extraordinary — giving their time, energy, and hearts to help others.

Christmas Hamper Program

This year, Redcliffe Mums Inc. again played a key role in the **Redcliffe Community Care Network**. Together with other local not-for-profit organisations, we packed and distributed **almost 500 Christmas food hampers** to individuals, couples, and families doing it tough. Thanks to the **City of Moreton Bay**, we were also able to include bacon and eggs in each hamper — a small touch that made a big difference.

We also helped provide **Christmas gifts for children**, ensuring more families experienced some joy during the holidays.

Looking Ahead

This year, Redcliffe Mums Inc. has raised vital funds for the community, supported dozens of families and schools, and strengthened our impact through collaboration. We've proven that even a small team can make a big difference.

Redcliffe Mums Incorporated is a registered Not-for-Profit organisation, endorsed by the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC) and the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) for Charity Tax Concessions and Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status. We currently have a dedicated team of eight volunteer committee members, all of whom are committed to upholding the highest ethical standards. Our team is made up of passionate individuals from the Moreton Bay community—not just mums—who have come together to support local families in need. We believe in the power of community and are committed to making a meaningful difference in the lives of those who are struggling.

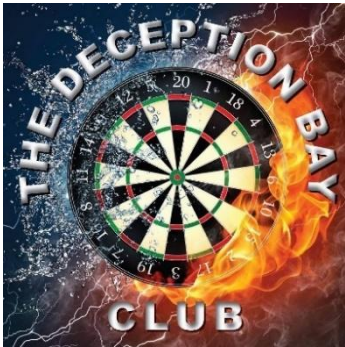

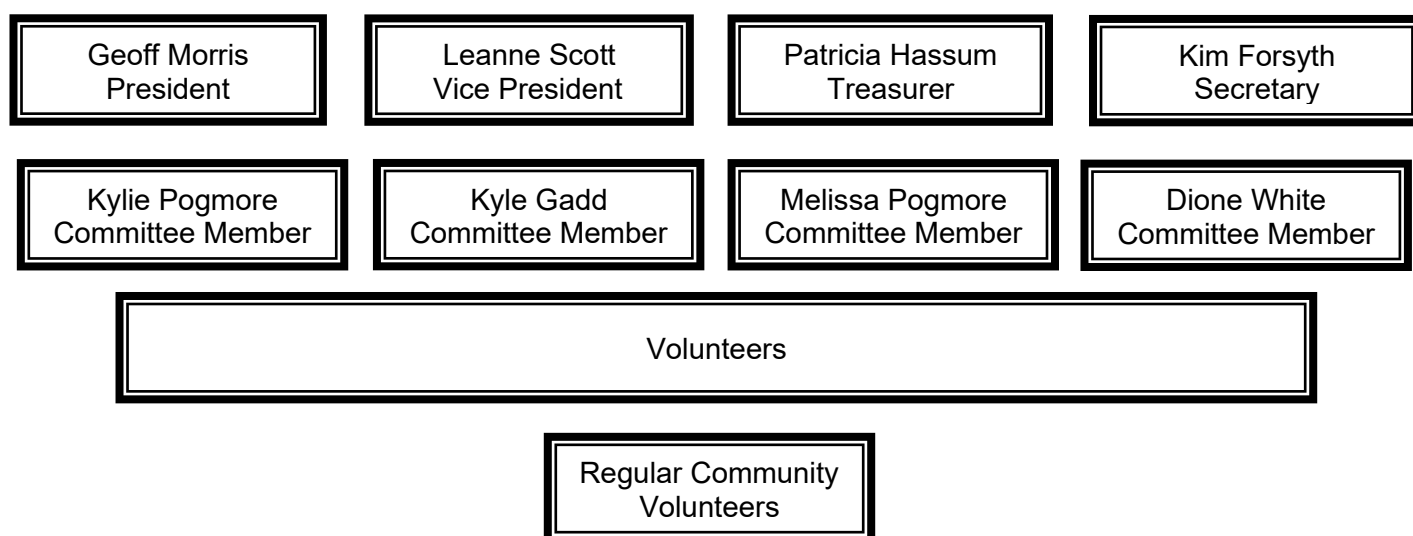

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT - Geoff Morris

Welcome committee and members to our AGM for Redcliffe Mums Incorporated.

For Redcliffe Mums 2024 was a year of learning and growth, and reaching further to help more children and people within the community.

This financial year we have officially added two more schools which takes us to a total of 16 schools we are supporting on the Redcliffe Peninsula, Deception Bay, Kallangur and Caboolture. Hopefully we can extend our schools again in 2025.

We have received the following Grants this year;

*\$1,165 from the City of Moreton Bay for our Trivia Night
\$6,000 from the City of Moreton Bay to purchase food items for the hampers at Christmas.
\$1,000 from the Department of Social Security to help support our amazing volunteers.
\$200 from the City of Moreton Bay to purchase our new pull up sign.
\$945 from the City of Moreton Bay towards our Trivia Night
\$747 from the City of Moreton Bay for our Trivia Night*

We have been lucky to receive a total of \$10,057.00 this year in grants.

We have held four Trivia Nights & been part of Motorfest and several Road Rage Events this year, with these events we have raised \$20,878.14 which is amazing.

We have received \$3,540.00 in regular donations from members of the community, we really do appreciate and value their continued support.

We have also received \$1,600.00 from our affiliation with Newport Markets which has unfortunately ended this year.

This year we have done two contributions to our schools and donated \$18,110.00. We still have five schools to contribute to in early 2025 and also need to organise photos with all of the schools.

With the support of the City of Moreton Bay we have also purchased \$6,036.84 in food toward hampers for disadvantaged members of the community.

This year we again co-hosted the Back-to-School appeal in January 2024 with The Breakfast Club. This was an amazing experience to be part of and we were able to help around approximately 200 families to get their children back to school. We also purchased \$403.34 worth of items to donate to this appeal.

We continued our work within the Redcliffe Community Care Network with the other not for profit organisations to support disadvantaged people around the community to get Christmas gifts for their children and a food hamper to help them. We worked throughout the year to plan and organise this Community Hamper drive & were able to help almost 500 people with hampers & presents for their children. We loved being part of this combined effort to support people in our community.

We started our affiliation with Road Rage & Motorfest Events by selling raffles at each of their events we were able to raise \$3,138.31 from the Motorfest event & approximately \$1,200.00 from Road Rage Events.

We have received an amazing amount of support from the City of Moreton Bay who have supported most of our events this year which allows us to raise more funding.

We have been lucky to have some generous members of the community that have continued to regularly donate funds to us and thankful to the amazing local business that have donated prizes for our events. It has been incredible to see the support and kindness from the community.

Redcliffe Mums has achieved a lot over the year, raising funds for the community, creating fundraising events to help disadvantaged families and expanding our reach by working with the Redcliffe Care Network.

We have again achieved a lot for such a small group of people and we all should be proud of what we have been able to do. Thank you to our committee members and volunteers for all of your hard work, time and efforts throughout the year and thank you to the businesses and members of the community that are continually supporting us, we could not do this without you.

OUR OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Over the past year, Redcliffe Mums Inc. has continued to grow as a community-focused Not-for-Profit, with a strong emphasis on building awareness, strengthening partnerships, and supporting families in need. Our core objective has remained consistent: to be a positive, impactful presence in the City of Moreton Bay by delivering practical support to disadvantaged children and their families.

One of our key goals has been to expand the number of schools we currently support. We've worked closely with school communities to identify students and families in need, and we are committed to deepening these relationships to broaden our impact.

Throughout the year, we've held several successful fundraising events—including Trivia Nights, road rage events, Motorfest and a community car wash. Together, we have distributed hampers and Christmas presents to families in need and partnered once again with The Breakfast Club to coordinate the Back-to-School Appeal in January 2024.

Our ability to support the community has been enhanced through partnerships with organisations such as Motorfest and Road Rage Events. These collaborations have introduced Redcliffe Mums to new audiences and increased our fundraising capacity. We look forward to continuing these relationships and exploring further opportunities in the year ahead.

While our affiliation with Newport Markets concluded during the year, we are grateful for their past support and wish them all the best. We would also like to acknowledge the ongoing contributions from the Bell Social Club, QCWA Clontarf, Heritage Peoples First Community Lottery, Smoking Butts & Racks, and many generous individuals who continue to support our mission behind the scenes.

We remain focused on developing strategic affiliations with other local organisations and stakeholders to strengthen our presence and increase the resources available to families in need. We've received grant funding from the City of Moreton Bay, which has enabled us to run events where most of the proceeds go directly to supporting local school communities. Additional support from the Department of Social Services has allowed us to recognise the hard work of our volunteers who give so generously of their time.

Another major highlight was our participation in the Redcliffe Community Care Network's end-of-year hamper drive. We were honoured to help plan, pack, and distribute these hampers, and we are committed to expanding this initiative moving forward.

Looking to the future, we are exploring new partnerships and events that will continue to raise funds for school items and essential support services. We will also continue applying for grant opportunities to fund our community programs and help us reach more families.

Additional Objectives for 2025:

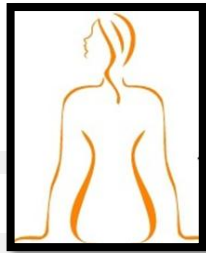
- ***Volunteer Development:*** Expand our volunteer base and offer structured onboarding and recognition programs.
