Through practical support and community collaboration, we work to give children the resources they need to thrive both at school and in life.

Our Mission

At Redcliffe Mums Incorporated, our mission is to provide practical educational support to children and families experiencing financial hardship.

Through fundraising initiatives, community events, partnerships, grants, and generous donations, we help cover the essential costs associated with schooling, including:

- *School fees and other educational essentials*

By providing brand-new school supplies and educational resources, we aim to restore confidence, dignity, and a sense of belonging—helping children feel equal among their peers and fully included in their education.

Every contribution we receive directly supports local children and families, allowing them to focus on learning, growth, and opportunity rather than financial stress.

Redcliffe Mums Inc. – 2025 Year in Review

2025 has been an incredibly rewarding year of growth, collaboration, and community impact for Redcliffe Mums Incorporated.

Throughout the year, we strengthened our organisation, expanded our network of supporters and community partners, and increased the support we provide to local families and schools. Thanks to the dedication of our volunteers and the generosity of our supporters, we were able to assist more children across our region than ever before.

Seeing the positive impact of this support—helping children access the essentials they need to learn, participate, and thrive—continues to inspire everything we do.

Growing Our Reach

This year, we continued building strong partnerships with schools across the Redcliffe Peninsula, Deception Bay, Kallangur, and Caboolture.

As awareness of our organisation continues to grow throughout the City of Moreton Bay, we are excited to further expand our reach and support even more families in the years ahead.

Grant Funding & Support

*In 2025, we were proud to secure a total of **\$13,958 in grant funding** to support our programs and community initiatives.*

This included:

- **\$6,599 from the City of Moreton Bay** to purchase bacon, eggs, and non-perishable food items for Christmas hampers distributed through the Redcliffe Community Care Network.
- **\$4,694 from the City of Moreton Bay** to support our community fundraising events, including Trivia Nights and Cent Auctions, while also funding permanent signage and promotional materials for our events.

- **\$2,665 from the Department of Social Services and Luke Howarth** to purchase a laptop and accessories to support the ongoing operations of our organisation.

We are deeply grateful for this support, which enables us to continue delivering meaningful assistance to local families and children.

Throughout the year, we hosted and participated in a number of successful community events, including:

- Road Rage Events

*Together, these initiatives raised an incredible **\$22,814.15** to support local families and children.*

*We are especially grateful for our growing partnership with Peninsula Motorfest, which contributed almost **\$8,056.91** through Road Rage and Motorfest fundraising activities.*

We also extend our sincere thanks to the many local businesses that donated prizes and raffle items for our Cent Auctions and fundraising events.

Community Support & Donations

*In 2025, Redcliffe Mums Incorporated contributed **\$13,500** directly toward supporting local schools and students through uniforms, stationery, educational supplies, and emergency assistance.*

*We also donated **\$6,809.25** in food donations for the Christmas hampers delivered to the community at Christmas.*

We continue to be humbled by the generosity of our community, including businesses, donors, and our incredible volunteers who dedicate their time, energy, and compassion to helping others.

Christmas Hamper Program

*This year, we once again proudly partnered with the Redcliffe Community Care Network to help pack and distribute almost **500 Christmas food hampers** to individuals, couples, and families experiencing hardship.*

With support from the City of Moreton Bay, we were also able to include bacon and eggs in each hamper — adding a special touch for families during the holiday season.

In addition, we helped provide Christmas gifts for children to ensure more families could experience joy, hope, and support during a difficult time of year.

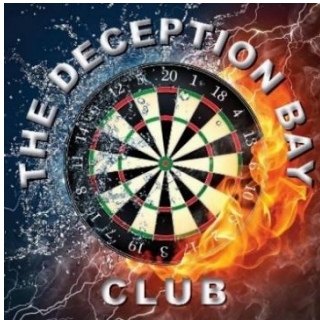

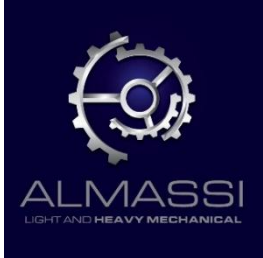

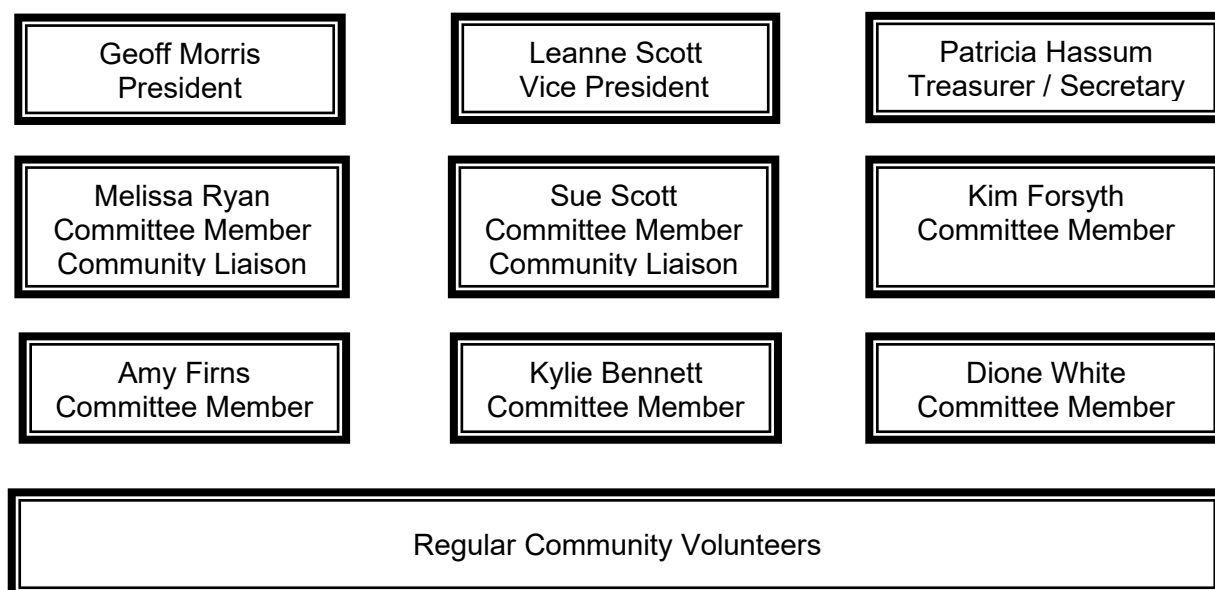

For Redcliffe Mums, 2025 has been a year of change, growth, and expansion, we have focused on expanding our reach within the community to support more children and families.

This year we have been able to make two donations to the 16 schools that we support across the Redcliffe Peninsula, Deception Bay, Kallangur, and Caboolture areas. We hope to continue growing this support network and extend our reach even further in 2026.

*This year we were fortunate to receive several grants from the **City of Moreton Bay** and other supporters. These included:*

- \$500.00 from the City of Moreton Bay for Trivia Prizes.
- \$755.00 from the City of Moreton Bay for a Trivia Night
- \$1,144.00 from the City of Moreton Bay for a Trivia Night including a new banner.
- \$900.00 from the City of Moreton Bay for Trivia Prizes for two events.
- \$2,665.00 from the Department of Social Services & Hon Luke Howarth MP, for the purchase of a new laptop computer and accessories.
- \$6,599.00 from the City of Moreton Bay for the purchase of bacon, eggs, and non-perishable food items for hampers for the disadvantaged members of the community.
- \$1,395.00 from the City of Moreton Bay for a new metal sign, a sandwich board, and items for a trivia night.

*In total, we received **\$13,958 in grant funding this year**, which has greatly supported our ability to continue helping local families.*

*Throughout the year we held **four Trivia Nights** and participated in **Motorfest** and several **Road Rage** events, which together raised an incredible **\$23,374.15***

*We also received **\$3,000.00 in regular donations from members of our community**, and we sincerely appreciate the generosity and continued support of those who contribute to our cause.*

*During the year we were able to provide **two rounds of contributions to our schools**, donating **\$13,500.00 the schools were paid over two financial years**. The sixteen schools all received \$1,000 either at the end of 2024 or the beginning of 2025 and then received a further \$500.00 in mid-2025. These donations are to support students with essential school items. We also have the finances there to donate \$1,000 to each of the 16 schools which will be happening in early 2026.*

*With the support of the City of Moreton Bay, we also purchased **\$6,809.25 worth of food items** to create hampers for disadvantaged members of the community.*

*We continued our involvement with the **Redcliffe Community Care Network**, working alongside other local not-for-profit organisations to support disadvantaged families during the Christmas period. Throughout the year we helped plan and organise the Community Hamper Drive, which assisted **almost 500 people** with food hampers and Christmas gifts for their children. It was wonderful to be part of such a collaborative effort supporting our community.*

*Holding our four **Trivia Nights** this year we raised **\$15,317.24** from these events; we had planned to only hold three events but caved to public pressure to hold our fourth Trivia event for the year.*

*This year we continued working with **Road Rage** and **Motorfest**, selling raffles at their events. Through this partnership we raised **\$6,063.10 at Motorfest** and **approximately \$1,993.81 through Road Rage events**.*

We have been incredibly fortunate to receive strong support from the City of Moreton Bay, who have supported many of our events and fundraising activities. Their support allows us to continue raising vital funds for families in need.

We were also very grateful to Hon Luke Howarth MP and the Department of Social Services who awarded us a grant to upgrade our laptop computer as we are in dire need for a new one, thank you for supporting us.

We are also very grateful to the many generous community members and local businesses who regularly donate funds and prizes for our events. The kindness and support shown to Redcliffe Mums is truly inspiring.

Over the past year Redcliffe Mums has achieved a great deal — raising funds, organising community events, supporting schools and disadvantaged families, and strengthening our partnerships with other local organisations.

For a small group of dedicated volunteers, this is something we should all be extremely proud of.

Finally, I would like to sincerely thank our committee members and volunteers for their hard work, time, and dedication throughout the year. I would also like to thank the businesses and community members who continue to support us. Without you, none of this would be possible.

We also continued working alongside local not-for-profit organisations through the Redcliffe Community Care Network. Together, we supported families doing it tough by helping coordinate, pack, and distribute Christmas hampers and gifts to local households in need during the holiday season.

Our partnerships with organisations such as Peninsula Motorfest and Road Rage Events have significantly strengthened our fundraising capacity and introduced Redcliffe Mums Incorporated to new audiences within the wider community. These collaborations have played an important role in our growth, and we look forward to continuing and expanding these relationships into the future.

We would also like to sincerely acknowledge the ongoing support of Bell Social Club, local businesses, community partners, and the many generous individuals who continue to support our mission both publicly and behind the scenes. Their contributions are invaluable and allow us to continue delivering support where it is needed most.

Throughout the year, we remained focused on building strategic relationships with local organisations, businesses, schools, and community stakeholders to strengthen our impact and improve the support available to families in need. Grant funding received from the City of Moreton Bay enabled us to deliver community events and direct the majority of fundraising proceeds back into supporting local school communities. Additional support from the Department of Social Services assisted us in recognising and supporting the incredible volunteers who generously give their time to our organisation.

Another significant highlight was our involvement in the Redcliffe Community Care Network end-of-year Christmas hamper initiative. We were proud to assist with the planning, packing, and distribution of hampers and gifts, helping bring relief and joy to families during a particularly difficult time of year.

*Through a successful grant from the City of Moreton Bay of \$6,599, together with additional funding support, we were able to purchase **\$6,809.25** worth of non-perishable food items, and bacon and eggs, for inclusion in Christmas hampers distributed to struggling community members and families across the region. This support helped ensure many local households were able to enjoy a more dignified and supported Christmas during challenging times.*

We are committed to continuing and expanding our involvement in this important community initiative moving forward.

Looking ahead, Redcliffe Mums Incorporated is focused on continuing to grow our impact across the region. We are actively exploring new partnerships, fundraising opportunities, and community events that will allow us to provide greater support to children and families in need. We will also continue pursuing grant opportunities to strengthen and expand our community programs.

Sustainable Fundraising

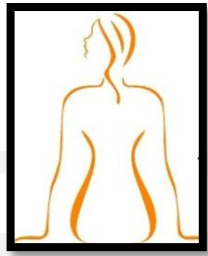
